




Saturday May 2
Low Net by Flights

This Event is a Low Net Event by Flight.
Net Scores are calculated by subtracting your handicap from your actual Score.

New members who do not have a handicap will have a handicap calculated using the Callaway Handicap System and will be slotted in Flights based on the calculated handicap.

Saturday May 9
Stableford by Flights

This Event is a Stableford Event by Flight.

Points are scored based on Net Score on each hole.
Points are calculated as follows:

Net Double Bogie or Greater	-3
Net Bogie	-1
Net Par	0
Net Birdie	+2
Net Eagle	+5
Net Double Eagle	+8

The player with the most points is the winner.

New members who do not have a handicap will have a handicap calculated using the Callaway Handicap System and will be slotted in Flights based on the calculated handicap.

Saturday May 23
Sundance May 24

2 Man Best Ball by Flights

This event is a 2 Day 2-Man Best Ball by Flight Event.
The Team Score on each hole is the Best Net Score of the Team.

4 Flights will be used for this event.

90% of a player's course handicap will be used for this event.

Tee Times for Sunday will be assigned based on Saturday's results.

Flights will be grouped with Leaders playing in the last groups.

Saturday June 6

4 Man Team (2 by 4)

This Event is a 4 Man team Event.

On holes 1, 9, 10 and 18
the team will count all net scores

On the remaining holes the team will count 2 lowest net scores.

Sunday June 14

2 Man Team (Racehorse)

This Event is a 2 Man Race Horse Event.

On each hole points are scored based on all team member's Net Score

All scores count towards the Teams Point Score.

Net Bogie	1 point
Net Par	2 points
Net Birdie	3 points
Net Eagle	4 points
Net Double Eagle	5 points

Sunday June 28

Match Play/Low Net

This Event is a Match Play/Low Net Event
All Matches are 9 Hole matches
Saturday First Nine
1st Player vs 2nd player on scorecard.
3rd Player vs 4th player on scorecard.
Winners on 1st nine on Saturday play each other and are in **Winners bracket**.
Losers on 1st nine on Saturday play each other and are in the **Consolation bracket**.
If you lose your 2nd match on Saturday you are entered in Low net for Sunday.
On Sunday, if you are in the consolation bracket, all players are in the Low Net event except for the Consolation winner.
The loser of the 3rd place match in a flight is also in the Low net event.

Saturday July 11
2 Man Quota
This Event is a 2-Man Team Event Using the Quota System.

Points are awarded to each player based on their actual score on a hole.

Each Player is given a Quota which is calculated by subtracting a players handicap from 36.
The minimum quota for a player is 4 points per day (Only pertains to those players who have a handicap of over 32)

Saturday July 25
Sunday July 26
Sundance Classic

This Event is a 5-Man Team Event Using the Quota System.
Points are awarded to each player based on their actual (gross) score on a hole.
Each Player is given a Quota which is calculated by subtracting a player's handicap from 36.
The minimum quota for a player is 4 points per day (Only pertains to those players who have a handicap of over 32)

Points Calculation

Par	2 Points
Birdie	3 Points

Tournament Qualifications Classic

- **Sundance Classic (July 25/26)**
- A member must have played a minimum of six **(6) registered rounds of golf** at Sundance Golf Course in 2009.
- A member must have played and completed a minimum of **two (2) Men's Club Events**.
- For the 2009 season these qualifications must be met by **July 12, 2009** (Two weeks before the tournament).
- **The Classic sign up deadline is Sunday, July 12, 2009**

Saturday August 1
4 Man Team (1/2/3)

This Event is a 4 Man team Event.
The team will count scores as follows:
One net ball on par 3's
Two net balls on par 4's
Three net ball on par 5's.

Saturday August 22
Sunday August 23
Club Championship

This event is the Club Championship of the Sundance Men's Club.
The following events are featured in this Tournament.

- 1.) Low Net by Flights - Trophy 1st Place
- 2.) Low Gross Overall - Trophy for 1st Place
- Low Gross Senior (Must be 55 by Aug 22, 2009 and not qualify for Super Senior.)-Trophy for 1st Place
- 4.) Low Gross Super Senior (Must be 65 by Aug 22, 2009)-Trophy for 1st Place

Tournament Qualifications Club Championship

- **Sundance Club Championship (August 22/23),**
- A member must have played a minimum of ten **(10) registered rounds of golf** at Sundance Golf Course in 2009.
- A member must have played and completed a minimum of **three (3) 2009 Men's Club Events**.
- For the 2009 season, these qualifications must be met by **August 9, 2009** (Two weeks before the Tournament).
- **The Club Championship deadline is Sunday, August 9, 2009**

Saturday September 12

2 Man Team (Combination)

This event is a 2-man Team event playing three (3) different formats.

Holes 1-6 Scramble
 Each 2-man team hits a tee ball and then will select their best ball to hit the 2nd shot. The teams 3rd best shot will then be selected and each will hit from that spot, and so on until the team holes their putt. .

Holes 7 – 12 Alternate Shot
 Each 2-man team hits a tee ball and then will select their best ball to hit the 2nd shot. The player whose ball was selected shall not hit the next shot, his partner will hit the 2nd shot. The alternate partner will then hit the 3rd shot and players will continue to take turns in a similar fashion until the ball is holed..

Holes 13-18 Best Ball
 Each member of the 2-man team will play their own ball for the entire hole. After the hole the team members will record their best ball for that hole.


Points Championship

This tournament is open to the top 100 players in the points standing for the year. This event will be a 2-day event where the best net score for a player for each hole for the 2 days will be used as his score for the event.

Points Championship

Points Championship

- Earn points three ways
 - Attend Meetings (2 points each)
 - Spring, Classic, Club Championship
 - Play Men's Club Events
 - Play MPGA Tournaments (2 points each)

Membership Obligation

- Each member shall during a season, play a minimum of **Fourteen (14) registered 18-hole rounds of golf at Sundance Golf Course.**
- Each member must play in at least **3 Men's Club Events.**
- Men's Club Tournament rounds played count toward the 14 round obligation.
- The 14 round obligation and 3 round event obligation must be met by **October 15, 2009.**

Event Sign-Up Information

- Sign-up sheets for all Sundance Men's Club Events will be posted in the Pro Shop.
- Sign-up is also available via our web site www.sundancemensclub.com
- Place your signature/initials in the blocks provided for each Event.
- sign up for early times by placing an "E" next to your initials or sign up for a late time by placing an "L" next to your initials.

Event/Cancellation

- **If you sign up for an Event and cannot play...**
 - please call **Tournament Chairman Claire Deering** at **(763) 560-0501 (home phone)** or at **(763) 639-0501 (cell phone)** as early as possible to cancel out of the Event.
 - Do not call the Pro Shop to cancel unless it is the day of the event.
 - Claire can also be reached via E-Mail at clairedeering@comcast.net.

No-Show/Pick-up during event

- If a player signs up for an event and does not show-up for tee time or walks off course, except for physical or emergency reasons, the following will apply:
 - Minimum penalty-suspension for next 2 events
 - This includes players who sign-up for a 2-day event and do not show up on 2nd day.

Hole-in-one Event

- The Hole-in-one event began on Saturday April 4, 2009 and ends on Saturday October 3, 2009.
- A Hole-in-one must be witnessed by another Sundance Men's Club Member and must be scored during a 9 or 18 hole stipulated round of golf played at Sundance Golf Course.
- The round of golf must be a legal round of golf which means playing a regular round (I.E. hitting a single ball on each hole etc).
- For special events such as Scramble or other Events where a member may be called upon to hit more than one ball, only the first ball can be used in the hole-in-one event.
- The hole in one **must be scored on a weekend or Holiday** to qualify for the Men's Club Prize money reserved for holes in ones.

Posting Scores

- **It is each member's responsibility to make sure score cards are posted for all rounds of golf played** (Do not assume someone else will post your score).
- Handicap Computer **located in the Pro Shop** near "Dave's Discount Dugout"

Posting a Tournament Score

- **EVENT SCORES WILL BE POSTED BY MYSELF OR DAVE...**
 - Turn in score card to the pro shop after tournament rounds
- Sundance Men's Club Members should **post Men's Club Events, 16 Man team Events, 8 man team Events, MPGA Events, MGA Events** and other forms of competitions as Tournament Rounds.
- Score cards should be adjusted for equitable stroke before they are posted on the computer for handicap purposes.

Handicap Review

- Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) sets a maximum number that a player can post on any hole depending on the player's Course Handicap. ESC is used only when a player's actual or most likely score exceeds his maximum number based on the table below.

Course Handicap	Maximum Number On Any Hole
9 or less	Double Bogey*
10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8
30 through 39	9
40 or more	10

New Members/Handicap

- To establish a Handicap for the Sundance Men's Club, a new member must play a minimum of **five (5) rounds of golf at Sundance Golf Course.**
- A new member may **play in the first 2 Individual Events of the year without a handicap.**
- New members who do not have a Handicap for the first 2 events of the year will have their Handicap calculated using the **Callaway Handicap System** and will be slotted by Flights based on the calculated Callaway handicap.
- All other events require a handicap.**

Posting scores in inactive season

Scores made at any golf course observing an *inactive season* are not acceptable for handicap purposes.

Scores made at a golf course in an area observing an *active season* must be posted for handicap purposes, even if the *golf club* from which the player receives a *Handicap Index* is observing an *inactive season*.

The club's *Handicap Committee* must make it possible for a player to post these away scores prior to the next *Handicap Index* revision. If possible, the club must re-compute the player's *Handicap Index* at that start of the *active season*.

**5th Annual State Mid-Amateur Championship
&
42nd Annual Individual Low Net
Championship
Pebble Creek Golf Course - Becker,
Minnesota
May 16-17, 2009**

ELIGIBILITY: The Championships are open to amateur players who are members of a men's club that is a member of the Minnesota Public Golf Association (MPGA) and carry an active GHIN handicap. In order to play in the Mid-Amateur (only), a player must be at least 35 years of age as of May 16, 2009.

FORMAT: The **Individual Low Net Championship** is a two-day, 36-hole event. This event will have divisions based on the number of entries and handicaps. Full handicaps will be applied after adjusting to the slope rating of the golf course.

MID-AM: The **State Mid-Amateur Championship** is a two-day, 36-hole event. This event will be one division stroke play (no handicap). If a tie occurs for first place, a sudden death playoff will take place.

**32nd Annual Four-Ball Championship
Southbrook Golf Course - Annandale, Minnesota
June 20-21, 2009.**

ELIGIBILITY: This championship is open to amateur players who are members of a men's club that is a member of the Minnesota Public Golf Association and carry an active GHIN handicap.

FORMAT: This championship will be divided into four flights. The Championship Flight will play with no handicap. The remaining entries will be split as equally as possible using a ranking of combined handicaps into three flights. Each team member will play with 90% of his sloped handicap. Starting times will be as follows assuming a full field: Championship and Division 2 will play Sat.PM, and Sun. AM and Divisions 3 and 4 will play Sat AM and Sun PM.

**58th Annual State Senior Public Links/Senior
Low Net Championship
Rum River Hills Golf Course - Ramsey Minnesota
July 18-19, 2009**

ELIGIBILITY: This championship is open to amateur players who are members of a men's club that is a member of the Minnesota Public Golf Association, carry an active GHIN handicap and are at least 50 years of age as of July 18, 2009.

FORMAT: The Tournament will be divided into four divisions.

The Championship Division (#1) will be elective and played at stroke play, no handicap (gross).

The remaining three divisions will be established based upon the player's handicap index and competition will be at net stroke play. The cumulative 36-hole score will be the player's score for the tournament.

**State Boys Junior Public Links Championship
Sundance Golf Course
July 21, 2009**

ELIGIBILITY This tournament is open to all male junior amateur players, ages 13 to 18, on July 21, 2009, who are affiliated with or play substantially all of their golf at a public golf course. The Junior Public Links Championship is a competitive event. Golf experience, including knowledge of rules and etiquette is required.

FORMAT This event is an 18-hole stroke play event. There will be multiple divisions based on age. Prizes will be given to the low 18-hole scores in each age division. The low 12 players and ties regardless of division will play an additional 9 holes. The Junior Public Links Champion will be the player with the lowest 27-hole score regardless of age division. The player with the low 27-hole scores regardless of age division will receive entry into the 2009 MPGA State Public Links Championship.

**85th State Public Links Championship
Logger's Trail Golf Course
Stillwater, Minnesota
August 8-9, 2009**

ELIGIBILITY: This tournament is open to amateur players who are members of a men's club that is a member of the Minnesota Public Golf Association. You must have a GHIN handicap index of 5.5 or less at the time of entry to be eligible to enter this Championship.

FORMAT: The tournament will be a two-day, 36-hole event for all entered players (no cut). **Threesome pairings will be used for this Championship.**

ENTRY: Entries will be limited to the first 90 received and must include entry fee. Entries are on a first come basis, until the field is full.

**24th Annual Combination Championship
Bunker Hills Golf Course
Coon Rapids, Minnesota
Sept. 19-20, 2009**

ELIGIBILITY: This Championship is open to amateur players who are members of a men's club that is a member of the Minnesota Public Golf Association (MPGA) and carry an active GHIN handicap.

FORMAT: This tournament is a 27 hole, one day event. Each two-man team will play nine holes partner best ball, nine holes partner scramble (best shot), and nine holes partner alternate shot.

Six divisions will be determined by the Committee based on the number of entries received and their combined handicaps.

Divisions I, II and III will play on Sunday, Sept. 20th. Divisions IV, V and VI will play on Saturday, Sept. 19th. Teams will play within their divisions with no handicap. The partner's handicap indexes may not differ by more than 8.0 at time of entry.
